SPRING BREAK GLIDING

1. Applications are being solicited for glider pilot qualified cadets to participate in Spring Break Gliding from 5 Mar 10 – 14 Mar 10. Training will take place at 19 Wing Comox, delivered by RCAOps (Pac). This is an excellent opportunity for cadets to gain valuable gliding experience as well as possible completion of their back seat rating.
2. 15 cadets will be selected to participate, predominately from the Vancouver Island/Northern Wings, followed by the Lower Mainland/Metro Vancouver/Greater Vancouver/Fraser Valley Wings and, the Okanagan/Kootenay Wing. This is due to the shortened gliding season on Vancouver Island and the North, and the overlap of spring break and the start of the gliding season in the Okanagan.
3. Cadets may apply using a CF-51 Application and Approval – Cadet Activities (Employment – Course – Exchange). Please clearly highlight “**Spring Gliding**” on the top of the front page of the form.
4. Adult supervisory staff will be selected through an application process. Staff duties will include driving, tow pilots, LCOs and glider instructors. Staff may apply using the Cdt #112 Application for Reserve Force Service at a Cadet Summer Training Centre – CIC Officer, Civilian Instructor, Civilian or Supp Res Member. Please clearly highlight “**Spring Gliding**” under ‘Cadet Summer Training Centre Desired’.
